1. Lligwy Beach




Accessed directly from the gates of Tyddyn Isaf, the vast expanse of golden sand creates a beach that is perfect for families. Lligwy Beach is dog friendly all year round and there is also a wonderful café which offers entertainment options during the summer months.



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2. Traeth Yr Ora




Traeth Yr Ora is a wonderfully secluded cove that is accessible only via foot. It makes the perfect location for a romantic stroll or even a tasty picnic. What's more – it is located walking distance from Tyddyn Isaf and has no dog restrictions.



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3. Cemlyn Bay





Cemlyn Bay sits in the North of Anglesey, approximately 20 minutes drive from Tyddyn Isaf. It is a majestically crescent shaped bay famed for being a North Wales Wildlife Trust reserve, a Site of Special Scientific Interest (SSSI), and a Special Protection Area (SPA) – an absolute must visit for birdwatchers. It is also a great location for spotting marine mammals such as bottle nose dolphins and grey seals.



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4. Newborough Forest and Beach



Meander through the tall Corsican Pines until you reach the wonderful sand dunes of Newborough Beach -a vast expanse of golden sand that is backed by enchanting woodland and overlooks the mighty peaks of Snowdonia. A great location for family friendly cycling or a great day at the beach. Be sure to walk along to neighbouring Llanddwyn Island, famed for its romantic history.



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5. Benllech Beach



Benllech Beach is a fantastic family friendly beach offering a plethora of fun activities for children over the summer months. Located just 5 minutes drive from Tyddyn Isaf this beautiful bay is perfect for building sandcastles and paddling to your hearts content!
