



Green Purchasing Policy

At Tyddyn Isaf, we are committed to reducing our environmental impact and promoting sustainable practices. As part of our commitment, we have developed a green purchasing policy that guides our purchasing decisions.

- **Sustainable Materials:**
We prioritise purchasing materials that are environmentally friendly and sustainable. We aim to use materials that have a lower impact on the environment, such as those made from recycled or natural materials.
- **Local Sourcing:**
We will aim to source materials and products from local suppliers and trades where possible to reduce transportation emissions and support the local economy. We aim to give preference to purchasing from suppliers who share our values and are committed to sustainable practices.
- **Energy Efficiency:**
We will seek energy-efficient products and services to reduce our overall energy consumption and promote a more sustainable energy footprint.
- **Packaging:**
We aim to purchase products with minimal packaging or packaging that is recyclable or compostable. We will work with our suppliers to reduce packaging waste.
- **Chemicals and Cleaning Products:**
We aim to purchase eco-friendly and non-toxic cleaning products and chemicals, such as those that are certified by organisations like Green Seal or EcoLogo e.g. Evans GreenTick range
- **Waste Reduction:**
We aim to purchase products with a long lifespan or that can be recycled or repurposed at the end of their life. We will avoid single-use products where possible and encourage our guests to do the same.
- **Certifications and Standards:**
We will prioritise products and services that adhere to recognised environmental certifications and standards, such as ENERGY STAR, Forest Stewardship Council (FSC), and other relevant eco-labels.

We will regularly review our green purchasing policy to ensure that we are meeting our sustainability goals and adapting to new technologies and practices.

We will also communicate our policy to our suppliers and staff to ensure that everyone is aligned with our sustainability goals.

By implementing this green purchasing policy, we are committed to reducing our environmental impact and promoting sustainable practices at Tyddyn Isaf Caravan Park.
