The prices quoted above (except walkers pitches) are the nightly rates inclusive of VAT for 1 unit (i.e. one tent, caravan, motorhome or campervan), 2 adults, any children under 2 years of age, 1 car and 1 dog. All children aged 2-15, extra adults, extra cars and any other add-ons will be charged per night at the rates detailed below. A walkers pitch is for a small 2-man tent max and does not include a car in the pitch price. An all-weather serviced pitch includes a water point and grey waste drainage point.

Only 1 pup tent allowed per booking. ***In some instances we may ask that additional cars or boats are parked in a separate parking area (see terms and conditions). In no circumstances are commercial transit vans permitted next to pitches.
